# Academy Head's Weekly Update



We've had another very busy and productive week in school. The children have continued to enjoy the warmer weather, although we are all pleased the temperature has dropped a little.

### **Moving Up Morning**

Moving Up Morning was a great success. The children enjoyed visiting their new classroom and spending some time with their new teachers. All children should have brought home a slip containing the name of their new teacher and their new class. If you are unsure about which class your child is moving to and who their class teacher will be, please do speak to your child's current class teacher.

#### **Sports Day**

We are looking forward to Sports Day on Monday. The weather forecast looks good at the moment so it should be going ahead as planned. Please could we ask for your assistance in ensuring your child comes to school wearing their PE kit and a t-shirt in their house colour. Children will wear their PE kit for the full day in school.

We would be grateful for your support in ensuring your child comes to school with a full water bottle, hat and sun cream already applied.

School registration will take place as normal at 8.45am. The school gates will close at this time.

The gates will re-open just before 9am for parents/carers who should make their way onto field to the designated area by 9.15am. There will be a coffee van on site should parents wish to purchase a drink.

There will be an area on the field where parents/carers can stand. The children will move around the arena, whilst scoring points for their team house. Once the carousel of sporting activities has finished, there will be some competitive races on the track. All children will be given the opportunity to compete in a race at the end of the carousel. The children will race against the class in their year group for some competitive fun.

We ask parents/carers to stay in their designated area throughout the event.
