

Maths

In maths this half term, the children are learning about place value, exploring the composition of numbers in a variety of representations. The children will also be learning both mental and formal written methods of addition and subtraction.



Reading

This term the children are reading Where the Mountain Meets the Moon by Grace Lin. This is a fantasy adventure inspired by Chinese folklore, which tells of the quest of the protagonist (Minli) to change her family's

fortune. During the lessons, the children will discuss key vocabulary and guestions that improve their understanding of the text.
